# Early Years and Childcare Service

- We provide information, advice and training to early years and childcare providers such as schools, nurseries, pre-schools and childminders. This includes guidance about Ofsted, EYFS, business, safeguarding children and inclusion.
- We administer early education funding to support families with their childcare costs:

# Role of a School Crossing Patroller

- ▶ Being a School Crossing Patroller for Portsmouth City Council ensures that all members of the public cross the road safely at the designated crossing point.
- ▶ You will play a huge role in children's lives by ensuring them that using a School Crossing Patroller to cross the road is the safest point of call
- ▶ You will also put a lot of parents at ease as they know their child will be safe crossing the road to get to school, especially when they are starting their independent skills.

# Working Hours

- ▶ This role is term time only, 2 hours per day (1 hour in the morning and 1 hour in the afternoon).
- ▶ There is the added bonus of being paid for all the school holidays (T+C apply).

# Training

- ▶ Full training will be given
- ▶ You will complete a minimum of 1 week's training/ shadowing with an experienced School Crossing Patroller on site.



# Uniform

You will be provided with all the uniform necessary for all weather conditions:

- ▶ Winter Coat
- ▶ Summer Jacket
- ▶ Winter Hat
- ▶ Summer Cap
- ▶ Winter Gloves
- ▶ Lollypop stick and bag
